A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SPIRIT RIVER IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPOINTING THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 150 of the Municipal Government Act, Being Chapter M-26 R.S.A. 2000, and amendment thereto, Council may, by bylaw require council to appoint the chief elected official from among the councillors.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of Spirit River, in the Province of Alberta considers it desirable for effective governance that the Town of Spirit River Council appoint the chief elected official from among the councillors.

1. CITATION

- a. This bylaw may be cited at "Appointing of the CEO".

2. PROCEDURES AND TERM

- a. Council will be required to appoint the chief elected official from among the councillors
- b. The term of the appointment shall be a one (1) year term.
- c. Council will appoint the chief elected official at the first council meeting following the Municipal Election. Subsequent appointments of the CEO will be held at the annual organizational meetings.


